



Coloured Finish Tapware

Care and Maintenance Guide

Innova's Coloured Tapware is made from high quality brass, finished with a stunning durable range of electroplated finishes. To maintain the quality and finish, follow these cleaning and care instructions, to ensure you maintain the beauty of the product you have selected and to preserve your warranty.

Care and Maintenance:

- Dry them with a soft cloth after each use. Microfibre cloths are ideal as they are soft and non abrasive.
- Clean with warm water or a mild ph-neutral liquid soap and water and polish with a clean microfibre soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cloths, scouring pads, scrub sponges, steel wool etc as they may damage the surface.
- Residue left from products such as liquid soap, toothpaste, shampoo and shower gel can cause damage to the finish. Always rinse these off the fittings with clean water immediately after use.
- No harsh cleaning chemicals or products to be used. Under no circumstances should harsh cleaning products that contain acidic, caustic or abrasive components such as bleach, alcohol, citrus or vinegar based products be used. Mild Ph-neutral soap and cleaners are recommended but should be rinsed and dried off immediately after cleaning.
- Steam cleaning is not recommended as high temperatures could cause damage.

To avoid damage and to maintain your colour finish is important to follow the recommended steps and instructions noted above when cleaning your product.
